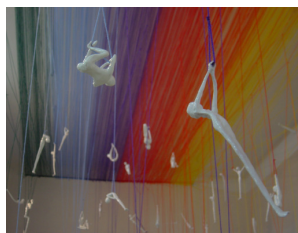

“Sometimes I think what I don’t understand”

From the 11th of May to the 21st of July 2006

On Thursday May 11 the gallery Ciocca Arte Contemporanea is pleased to inaugurate a new solo show of the artist Alex Pinna, titled “*Sometimes I think what I don’t understand*”.

To welcome the audience there are many coloured threads, suspended between sky and earth, from whom are descending one hundred and fifty sculptures in white ceramic. Small and fine characters suspended between a colourful rainbow, attract the audience through a look game that invites to look for a personal ray to unchain our self into a fabulous and an emotional world.

It is like a small and outstanding world, that is full of emotions and affections, where we can seek every time we get lost and every time we are guided by the strong possible desire, we are carried by this essential inner that is *Heart*.

Lungs is the title of the second work presented at the show, two armchairs, with an unmistakable design, become alive and raise consciousness of them selves. They are two indivisible units that the artist give the sight gift, or better, the gift of staring each other, by creating one-way relationship that doesn’t allow other interlocutor but the two armchairs.

It is the exceptionality and indivisibility of that relationship that allow us to live it as an exchange of their look and our breath.

Located in the external space of the gallery *Liver* ends Alex Pinna solo show. Many overcoats wrap the thin figure as various skin layers that separate and look after it from life. It is only through liver that we realize the physicality of a pain otherwise purely emotionally, so that loneliness and distance go deep into us as a contemplation of depths of reality.

Heart, *Lungs* and *Liver* are three different and complementary works, a whole of vital organ that shape a single body because human life is the result of a multiplicity of experiences that are growing our souls.
